Later, during the Eastern Han Dynasty between 40 to 200 A.D., Zhang Zhong jing recorded all of these clinical experience handed down from generations in the Shang Han Za Bing Lun (Treatise of Cold Complicated Diseases- 傷寒雜病論) which was later edited and separated in the Shang Han Lun (Treatise of Cold Damage- 傷寒論) and the Jin Gui Yao Lue (Prescriptions from the Golden Cabinet - 金匱要略).
